Use of electronic devices during examinations

The Examination Board passed the following resolution at its 143rd meeting on 10 December 2015:

Electronic devices that can be used to cheat in an examination (e.g. mobile phones, smartphones, smart watches, or any other devices that can be used for exchanging data and/or communicating) may only be kept switched off in bags underneath the tables. Any such devices that are switched on are fundamentally considered an attempt to cheat; the examination is therefore deemed to have been failed. The decision is at the supervisors' / examiners' discretion.
